Legal Aid of WV

What does Legal Aid of WV provide? Legal information, advice, referrals or representation, if you are eligible.

How can I be eligible for services from Legal Aid of WV? You are eligible for services if you have a low or limited income or if you are a victim of domestic violence.

What kinds of cases do they take? They handle cases that have to do with the following issues:

- Domestic violence and protective order
- Divorce/child custody/child support
- Bankruptcy/credit problems
- Housing
- Government benefits (SNAP, Medicaid, Social Security)
- Tax problems
- Veteran's issues

They do not handle criminal law, accidents, personal injury cases or class action lawsuits

What else do I need to know? If you have a hearing within 10 days, be sure to apply by phone.
